The Change goes into effect on Monday August 31, 2020. Below is a guide meant to assist you in your process of reopening your indoor dining operation. The guide calculates (on a presumptive basis) the seating of your facility based upon your current Retail Food Permit (Food Facility 1-15 seats, Food Facility 16-49 Seats and so on).

Your operation can be either a Max of 25% capacity or 100 people - Whichever of the two is fewer

25% Capacity - Guide for Retail Food Operations

All seating/tables are still under the requirement of 6' social distancing
